Behavior Agreement

Students going on choir tour are representing Pleasant Grove High School and Alpine School District. Please read and agree to the following expectations, guidelines and consequences:

Expectations:

1. Students will be courteous and show respect to their fellow students.
2. Be positive and polite to chaperones, drivers and festival participants.
3. Be mindful of others, especially hotel, festival and Disneyland guests.
4. Show respect for the bus, the hotel and other's property.
5. Be respectful of the places we visit.
6. Perform to the best of your ability. That's the whole reason we are going!
7. Listen to clinicians. No talking, sleeping, texting, etc. when we are in the workshops!

Guidelines:

1. **Curfew:** Students will be required to be in their rooms at the times indicated on the itinerary. Lights out means LIGHTS OUT! After room checks, your door will be taped and you will not be allowed to leave for any reason! If there is an emergency, CALL your chaperone. Students who leave their room will be sent home!!
2. **Hotel:** Do not move furniture or use it in any way other than its intended use. You are responsible for any damage. You are not allowed to go out onto the balconies. Students may congregate in a room before curfew as long as chaperones are informed, curtains are open and everyone is in the main living area.
3. **Bus:** Students will keep the bus clean and free from garbage. Students will ride on their assigned bus. You will be kind to your driver.
4. **Attend all events!** That's why you are here! Please keep yourself healthy. Nobody stays at the hotel!
5. **Be at the designated places on time! You will be fined \$1 for every minute you are late. Check your itinerary often and give yourself time to get where you need to be!!**
6. **Students must be in groups of at least 3 – AT ALL TIMES!** Your chaperone must know where you are at all times.
7. **Chastity:** No PDA. No blanket sharing on the bus; only one body under a blanket.
8. **Festival:** Students will be positive and supportive of all groups participating in the MIP festival. We will show respect for everyone.

Consequences:

If a student fails to follow the expectations or guidelines, they may be subject to one of the following consequences:

1. The student will be required to stay with their chaperone to be "babysat."
2. The student will pay \$1 for every minute they are late.
2. The student will be sent home at parent's expense.
3. The student will be required to pay for damages caused.

If it is determined necessary to send me (my student) home, I accept responsibility for the cost of my return.
