

Student Rules and Regulations:

1. **Your chaperone must know where you are at ALL times.**
 - Make sure that you have given your cell phone number to your chaperone and have their cell phone number.
 - If you don't have a cell phone you must stay with a group where you can be contacted. Please give your chaperone the name and number of the individual who can be contacted to get in touch with you.
2. **You must stay in your assigned airline seat and stay in your assigned room - NO EXCEPTIONS!**
3. **If mixed couples are in a room before lights out, you must inform all your chaperones and leave curtains open.**
 - Any inappropriate behavior will merit a phone call home and possible expulsion from the tour at YOUR expense.
 - No mixed couples in the back bedroom area!
4. **Do not use balconies at the hotel.**
 - There should be no yelling, throwing objects, leaping from balcony to balcony, loud music, etc. from any balcony.
 - Failure to comply may result in a phone call home or possible expulsion from the tour at YOUR expense.
4. **Alcohol, Tobacco products, or illegal drugs will NOT be tolerated.**
 - This includes anything that will alter your mood. Any prescription drugs that you bring must be listed on your medical form. Any person caught possessing or using any mood or mind altering substance will be immediately sent home at their expense, expelled from school, and subject to legal action.
5. **Use the buddy system at all times.**
 - DO NOT wander off by yourself!
 - You must stay in groups of three (3) or more. No exceptions!
 - Your chaperone must know where you are and who you with.
6. **Lights out means LIGHTS OUT!**
 - This means that you are in your own room in bed.
 - DO NOT leave your room after lights out for any reason.
 - Doors will be taped! If the tape is broken expulsion from tour is at stake.
 - If you have an emergency, contact your chaperone!
7. **Be kind and courteous to everyone.**
 - Remember that you represent Pleasant Grove, Utah. What you do will reflect on you, our school, community and state. Be a good ambassador!
 - SITUATIONAL AWARENESS!
8. **Be ON TIME!**
 - We are on a tight schedule. You will be fined \$1 for each minute that you are late for an event or departure. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Plan accordingly.
 - If you loose or forget your metro card you will have to buy a new one. We can't wait for you to go back and get it.
