1. **All payments should be made to the PGHS Finance Office under the student's name and placed in the Choir Tour account.** Receipts need to be brought to Mr. Wilcock. I must be able to keep these receipts for my records.
2. Director and Assistant Director expenses will be covered by the group and have been figured in to the final cost per person.
3. Some limited fund-raising opportunities will be offered. Students can work as hard as they like to earn money through these offerings but should have the means to pay for tour should these endeavors fall short. Money earned through fund-raising is non-refundable.
4. **STUDENTS AND CHAPERONES MUST BE 100% COMMITTED BY JANUARY 10, 2022.** Once committed by this date each student and chaperone will be responsible for paying for the entire trip. Should your situation change after this date you will still be responsible for paying the entire amount or finding another eligible choir student or parent of the same gender to take your place who is able to pay the remaining balance. It is up to you to work out any refunds between yourself and the person taking your place. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE CUT OFF DATE with the exception of district, state or federal mandates forcing cancellation. In this case everything will be done to refund as much of the money collected as possible.**
5. Students who have a confirmed truancy in any choir class may become **INELIGIBLE** to participate in the choir tour and will forfeit **ALL MONEY** paid regardless of when the truancy occurred. Each situation will be dealt with on an individual basis.
6. The following is a **suggested** payment schedule. This breaks the payments up into six (6) payments. **STUDENTS AND CHAPERONES ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO FOLLOW THE PAYMENT SCHEDULE. THE FULL AMOUNT OF \$925 MUST BE RECEIVED BY MARCH 15, 2022.** Students and chaperones failing to make payment in full by the last deadline may not be allowed to travel but will still be responsible for payment in full. Exceptions will be dealt with on an individual basis.
